2. Object of the Declaration

This declaration applies to the *plastic packaging in the form of plastic reels, plastic flanges, plastic cores and associated spacers made of polystyrene (PS)* manufactured by WEHA Plastic Technology GmbH.

The declaration contains a customer-specific article list in the Annex.

3. Declaration

The WEHA Plastic Technology GmbH declares under its sole responsibility that the packaging identified above complies with the requirements applicable to these products under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR).

The conformity assessment procedure pursuant to Article 38 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 has been carried out.

This EU Declaration of Conformity has been drawn up pursuant to Article 39 and Annex VIII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

4. Requirements Fulfilled

Article 5 – Restrictions on Substances

The sum of the concentrations of

- lead
- cadmium
- mercury
- hexavalent chromium

does not exceed 100 mg/kg.

Article 6 – Recyclability

The packaging consists of mono-material polystyrene (PS) and is, in principle, suitable for mechanical recycling.

Article 7 – Minimum Recycled Content in Plastic Packaging

The plastic reels already contain approx. 85 % recycled or reprocessed polystyrene. For the purposes of Article 7, the future eligibility for counting post-consumer recycled content (recycled material from consumer plastic waste) will be documented in accordance with the applicable EU methodology.

Article 10 – Minimisation

The weight and volume of the packaging have been reduced to the minimum necessary, taking into account their technical function.

Packaging Characteristics

Article 12 – Labelling

The packaging is labelled in accordance with the applicable labelling requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

Where additional digital labelling (e.g. QR code) is required in future by implementing acts, it will be implemented within the applicable statutory transitional periods.

5. PFAS

To the best of our current knowledge, no PFAS are intentionally added in the manufacture of the packaging referred to above.

6. Reuse – Article 11

The plastic reels are designed for multiple uses in industrial applications.

7. Technical Documentation

The technical documentation under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 is maintained by WEHA Plastic Technology GmbH in accordance with the statutory requirements.

It will be made available to the competent market surveillance authorities upon reasoned request.

8. Changes

Changes to products, materials or manufacturing processes that may affect the conformity covered by this declaration will be communicated to affected customers without undue delay.

Note on the Legal Status

This declaration was drawn up on the basis of the legal status of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 applicable at the time of its issue. Where future delegated or implementing acts establish additional requirements, this declaration will be amended accordingly.
